Contrition: Earnestly believe that God exists. I matter to Him, and He has the power to help me recover. (5:4; mourn)

Control: Consciously choose to commit all my life and will to Christ's care and control. (5:5; humble)

<u>Critique</u>: Openly examine and confess my faults to myself, to God, and to someone I trust. (5:8; pure in heart)

Craving: Voluntarily submit to every change God wants to make in my life and humbly ask Him to remove my character defects. (5:6; hunger and thirst for righteousness)

<u>Compassion</u>: Evaluate all my relationships, offer forgiveness to those who've hurt me, and make amends for harm I've done to others except when to do so would harm them or others. (5:7, merciful; 5:9, peacemakers)

Truth: Show mercy. Be pure. Make peace.

Soul: Who is near to <u>you</u> but far from God?

Passion: Make disciples who tend and mend the hurting.
