- 1. Act justly—that means we need to do what is right in every circumstance
- Love mercy—meaning that we need to look past our own hurt when someone hurts us and see how they may be hurting themselves. We need to look to the needs of others before ourselves. To summarize, Mark 12:28-29 tells us to Love God and Love people. When we are loving God, and extending the mercy he has shown us by giving His life as a sacrifice for our sin, then we are loving people.
